The Fremont County Community Foundation, an affiliate of the Omaha Community Foundation, has established the Fremont County Flood Fund with an initial deposit of \$5,000 from the Great Western Bank, Hamburg.

How to make a gift to help the Fremont County communities affected by the 2011 flood:

All that's needed is cash or a check of any amount made out to the **Fremont County Flood Fund**, your name and address. Drop off your donation at one of the bank locations below:

- First State Bank – Tabor
- Great Western Bank – Hamburg, Riverton, and Sidney
- Tri-Valley Bank - Randolph

If you wish to make an online donation, go to <http://omahafoundation.org/givenow> and select “Fremont County Flood Fund” from the dropdown list, enter the amount you wish to donate, fill in the required information (Name, Address, City, State, Zip, Phone, Email) and click the “Submit” button. You will be redirected to PayPal to provide your credit card information. (*A 3% merchant processing fee will be assessed for credit card donations.*)

Donations receive a gift receipt from the Omaha Community Foundation, which is a 501(c)(3) allowing maximum tax benefits.

100% of the monies from this fund will be distributed to nonprofit organizations that are directly serving flood victims in Fremont County.
